Free Admission to Adults. Any scout who cannot afford the fee should contact the registrar regarding a request for free admission.

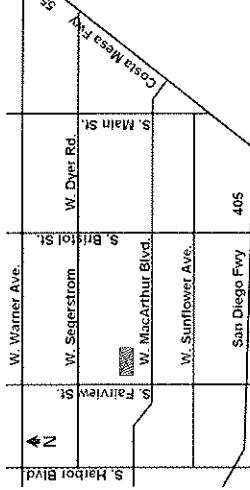

















GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Each Scout must bring: (a) completed "Blue Card" SIGNED BY SCOUTMASTER for each Merit Badge, (b) appropriate Merit Badge Books, (c) pen and paper, and (d) all other materials required for Merit Badge. Each Scout must be ready to discuss, report, demonstrate and be tested on ALL requirements. Our Counselors will not pass Scouts whose work does not meet BSA standards or is not properly documented.
2. See special instructions on reverse for requirements which must be completed before Merit Badge Day. Worksheets are also recommended to assist the Scout in preparation for the class (worksheets are NOT required).
3. No refund of registration fees for any reason after 5:00 p.m. April 19, 2008. First come, first served.
4. Scouts may register for one morning and/or one afternoon class.
5. Scouts must wear official BSA Scout uniform. Sufficient number of adult leaders must accompany all Scouts.
6. The cost is the same for one or two sessions. If you are attending one session, please specify 1st or 2nd session if you have a preference.
7. We cannot accommodate requests to have Scouts in the same class. Requests will be taken for Scouts with special needs.
8. Class availability, updates and registration forms will be available on the Website.
9. All requirement numbers are from *Boy Scout Requirements 2008*, which is the official list of requirements. Specific requirements that must be completed prior to class are listed below. This completed work should be brought to class and logsites allow. Otherwise bring written and/or photographic documentation of the completed requirements.
10. A Scout Master must sign the **written proof of completed requirements**.
11. If a Scout does not finish all requirements on Merit Badge Day, he will receive a "PARTIAL" for that merit badge and is encouraged to continue working with the counselor to finish the requirements as soon as possible.
12. Adults are invited to attend on-site training offered by the Rancho Del Mar District and/or volunteer to help out!
